From the Minister's Mac: The Symbols of Christmas



I had a dream last night where I was explaining the symbolism of the Christmas tree to my granddaughter. The Evergreen represents eternal life. The lights remind us of the light of Christ. The red ribbon and red ornaments stand for the blood of Christ, shed for us — "Just like on the candy cane," I told her. The beads encircling the tree represent all the people connected as the Body of Christ. The gold ornaments speak to the King-ship of Jesus and remind us of the gifts the Magi brought. In my dream she nodded and seemed to understand.

It was a dream, so let's just say she did.

All of the symbolism that speaks of our faith can get lost in the mad rush of the holiday season. That is why, on the first Sunday of Advent, I like to do a Hanging of the Greens litany, to explain how we have prepared the house of God for the coming of God's own son — and why — and to ask God's blessing on the Advent Wreath and the Christmas Tree.

As you prepare your own house to celebrate the birth of the Christ child, remember what you are doing and why. We are not just trying to win the Christmas Lighting Contest, or enjoy the flavor of a candy cane, we are engaging in the time-honored tradition of preparing our hearts for Christ, and not just our

hearts, but our churches and homes and communities.

May God bless all your preparations, and this year, may everyone on earth truly encounter the Christ Child.
