**Monthly Match.** The next monthly match will be held on **Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup>** at Paul Bunyan, with the shooter's meeting beginning at 9:30 am.

**Summer League.** Summer League this year consisted of 6 matches with three targets each. The 6 bulls-eye target received 5 shots (and one practice shot), the California X target received 5 shots, and the Buffalo target received 5 shots. The first two targets were shot at 25 yards and the buffalo was shot at 35 yards. For two of the six matches, we shot pistols on the same targets, but brought them to 15 and 25 yards. The final score was calculated by adding the best 5 match scores. By the end of the summer, there were only four shooters.
