- The Acadiana Roller Girls host local non-profits at all of our home bouts. They are able to set up a booth in order to get their information out to all of our fans. We are a non-profit organization who seeks not only to succeed in the athletic arena but also to give back to the community that supports us.

The Acadiana Roller Girls are Acadiana's first and only flat-track roller derby league. The team was established in 2009, making this our 10th season here in Lafayette! We are excited to announce that for our 2018 season, we have changed our home bout venue to Blackham Coliseum!



Roller derby is a high-contact competitive women -driven sport played on quad roller skates in accordance to WFTDA (Women's Flat Track Derby Association) regulations. While there are co-ed and men's derby team, ARG is a women's only team made up of women from all walks of life, who range in age from 18 to 108. We are students, artists, nurses, stay-at-home moms, teachers, scientists, botanists, social workers, and many other professions. Some are veteran athletes while others are new to playing team sports. The point is, anyone can join our 12 week Fresh Meat program and learn to play roller derby.

Our referees and coaches are the men and women that keep our skaters bout-ready and up to date with rules and regulations according to the WFTDA.

Non-skating officials (NSOs) are volunteers who are crucial to having smooth and successful operating bouts. NSOs keep score, track penalties, assist the referees, and volunteer to work any other positions needed.
