On October 21, at 5:04pm, Officer William Christopher was dispatched to check the welfare of a driver in a vehicle parked in the Sicomac School parking lot. Upon his arrival, he positioned his patrol vehicle behind the vehicle in question. As he did this, the driver of the vehicle started their engine and put the vehicle into gear in an attempt to start backing. Officer Christopher was able to stop the vehicle before leaving. The subsequent investigation led to the arrest of Jacquelin M Tiffinger, Oakland, age 62. She was charged with driving while intoxicated, driving while intoxicated in a school zone and reckless driving. She was released to a family member and is scheduled to appear in municipal court. Sergeant Mark Tagliareni and Officer Ryan Tenney assisted.
