YOU MUST MEET THESE QUALIFICATIONS

- 1 YOU MUST BE A RESIDENT OF GORDON COUNTY.**
You will be required to provide proof of Gordon County residency via a lease or utility bill.
- 2 YOU MUST HAVE CUSTODY OF THE CHILD OR CHILDREN.**
Children ages birth to 18 accepted. Child(ren) must be at least ONE (1) day old at the time of application. Child(ren) ages 15-18 must have proof of enrollment in school.
- 3 YOU MUST MEET INCOME GUIDELINES.**
All adults in the household will need to provide 30 days proof of income. Acceptable income documents include pay stubs, benefits letters, prior year tax forms such as 1099, W2, or tax returns. If there is not income in the household or you are paid with cash you must provide a food stamps benefits letter.
- 4 YOU MUST ATTEND ONE COMMUNITY EDUCATION CLASS.**
Classes are offered through Family Connection of Gordon County in collaboration with local partners. You are required to attend at least one class from the attached list. When you complete the class, you will receive a certificate of attendance. You must present the original certificate of attendance to the Voluntary Action Center when you submit your application.
- 5 APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED IN PERSON AT THE VAC.**
Once you have attended the class you need to complete the back of this form and bring the required documents to the VAC. You must bring ALL documents with you at the time you complete your application, no exceptions. Once your application is approved you will receive a pick-up slip with your family number.

- Picture ID **OR** Birth Certificates for all adults in the household.
- Birth Certificates, **OR** Verification of Birth, **OR** Shot Records for children birth to 18.
- 30 Days PROOF OF INCOME (Provide one of the following):** Paystubs, **OR** Government Benefits Letters, **OR** Bank Statements, **OR** Prior Year W2s, 1099s, or tax returns. ***If you do not have income YOU MUST PROVIDE FOOD STAMPS BENEFITS LETTER.***
- Proof of Residency:** Electric Bill, **OR** Gas Bill, **OR** Lease Agreement, **OR** Rent Receipt. ***The bill or lease does not have to be in your name but for the address where you live.***
- Community Education Class Certificate:** Will be provided to you by the class instructor when you complete an education opportunity from the attached list.
