

Mayoral Proclamation

On this 16th day of March 2020, I, Jerry Wallis, Mayor of the City of Moran, Kansas hereby recognize, find and proclaim as follows:

The Covid-19 virus represents a serious and substantial threat to the health and safety of the citizens of the City of Moran, Kansas and the city's employees.

The scope and validity of this threat is evident in the national emergency declaration issued by President Trump and the emergency declaration for the state of Kansas issued by Governor Kelly.


Although there are no confirmed cases in the City of Moran or Allen County at this time, it is necessary and appropriate that precautionary and proactive steps be taken to stop the spread of Covid-19 virus and reduce our citizens' and employees' risks of exposure to the virus. To achieve our goal of safeguarding the health of our citizens and employees the City will take the following actions:

Effective Monday 3/16/2020 at 8:00 a.m. the City of Moran will:

- 1) Close City Hall to public access. City staff may be contacted by telephone or email between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Utility payments may still be made via the drop slot at the front of the building or through credit and debit cards over the telephone.
- 2) Suspend all activities at the Moran Senior Center and close the building to public access.
- 3) Suspend all programs at the Moran City Library and close the building to public access.
- 4) Close public access to 54 Fitness Center.

These precautionary measures shall remain in place until 8:00 a.m. Tuesday, March 24th and may be adjusted based upon additional information we receive from medical experts and government officials.
