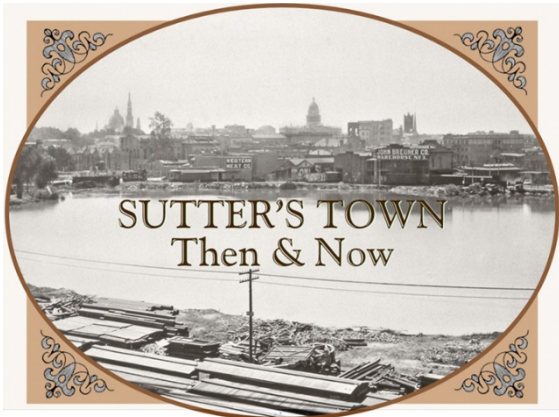


Sutter's Town Then & Now

Shirley Burman, our speaker, is a documentary photographer, artist, book & publication author and railroad women's historian. Her presentation is on photographs of historical Sacramento and the surrounding area. Working for the California State Parks in the 1970s as an illustrator and photographer, she was assigned to the California State Railroad Museum during its construction. She

has lectured on women and the railroads at the Smithsonian, the Oakland Museum, Penn State University and others. She and her late husband, Richard Steinheimer, collaborated on commercial photography with an emphasis on railroads. Burman received a BA in Art from the University of California-Davis in 1972. She was an illustrator for the California State Parks in 1974, and a documentary photographer for the U.S. federal government in 1976. She resumed employment with the California State Parks in 1978 as a photographer for the California State Railroad Museum's restoration projects. Since 1983, Burman has been a self-employed railroad photographer, designer and speaker. Together with her late husband, the railroad photographer Richard Steinheimer, she produced a book, "Whistles Across the Land", in 1994 and authored in other books and publications.
