- 2. Ages of animals will be reckoned from Sept. 1st -- that is born before August 31st will be one year old, and after Sept. 1st will be two years old, etc.
- 3. Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions, must be removed from the fairgrounds.
- 4. Pen lambs consist of two ram lambs and two ewe lambs.

- Produce of Dam shall consist of two doe of different ages. The produce of Dam need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Dam.
- 3. A Dairy Herd shall consist of three milking doe of one breed, any age.
- 4. The Senior Champion Class shall consist of all first place winners in the first classes, or Doe 1 year old and under 2, in milk and older animals.
- 5. The Junior Champion Class shall consist of all first place winners in classes 2 and 3, or Doe one year old and under 2 years, not in milk and younger animals.
- 6. Grand Champion Class shall consist of best of breed in each division.
- 7. Only Doe entered in other classes may compete in Get of Sire, Produce of Dam and Milking Herd classes.
