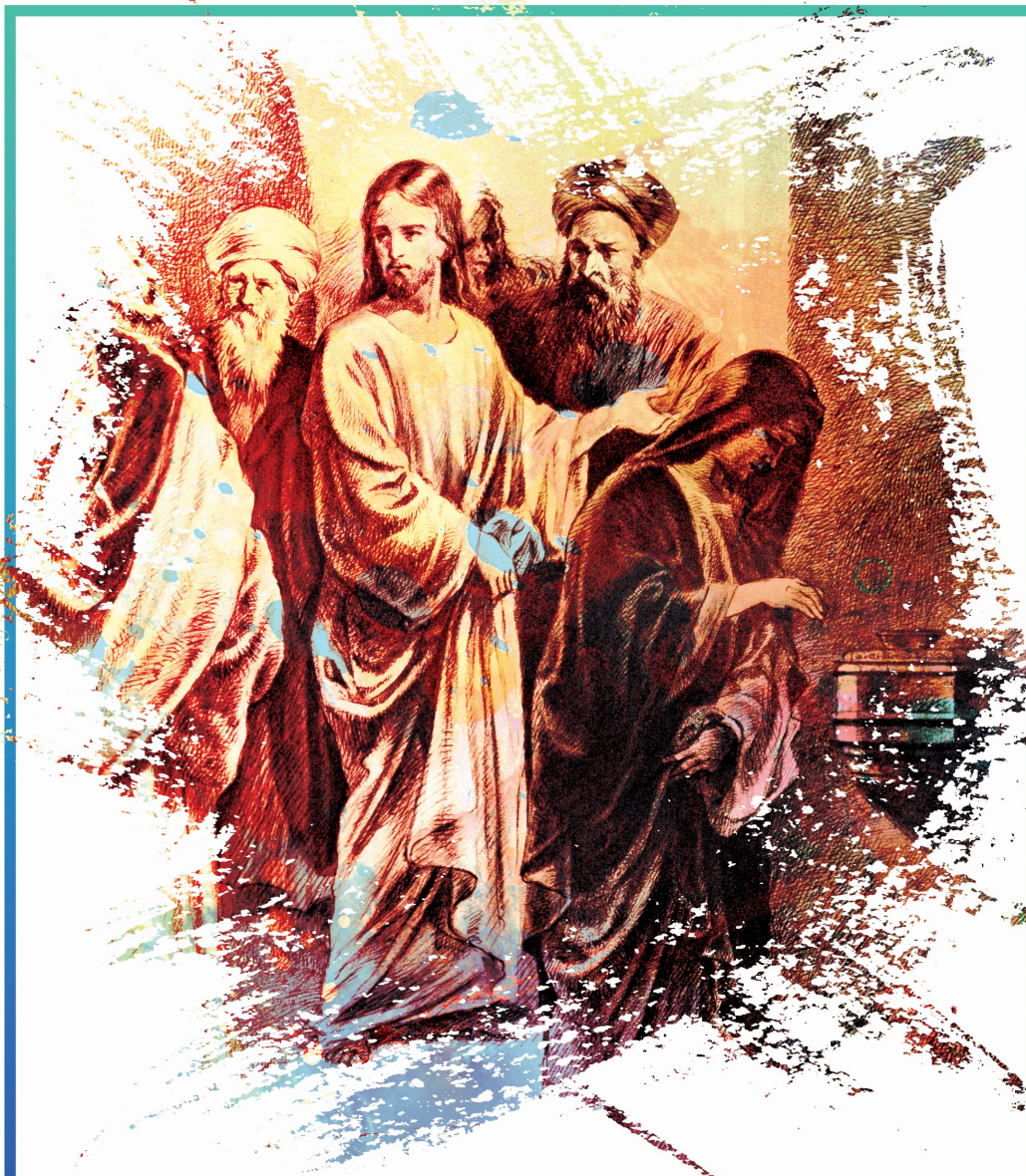

### St. Martin of Tours November 11



The feast day of St. Martin of Tours is celebrated every year on November 11. It is often called “Martinmas” and is a large celebration, especially in Germany.

St. Martin was born in Hungary and is the patron of soldiers. One story of St. Martin describes how he cut his own garment he was wearing in half to give to a beggar.

There are a lot of traditions associated with Martinmas, like crafting and processing with lanterns while singing, having a bonfire, and feasting!

The focal point of Martinmas is creating a lantern to process with. The lantern is a reminder that we are all a light in the world, like how St. Martin was a light to the beggar he gave his clothes too. What a nice reminder for us to remember to be a light to all.

**SMALL GROUP WEEK – November 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>**

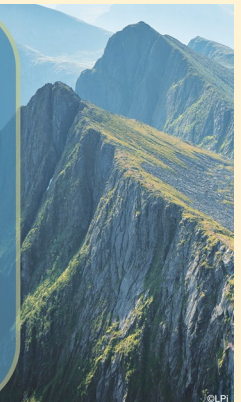

## **THE MORE YOU KNOW**

Any Catholic may perform an emergency baptism, such as if a person is in grave danger of death. In such a case, the validity of the baptism only depends upon the wishes of the person being baptized, that they desire the baptism. There are specific guidelines for such practices that Catholics should follow. Anyone wishing to be prepared for such a case should refer to the catechism for a deeper understanding of this allowance. Generally, such practices ought to be left to trained clergy.

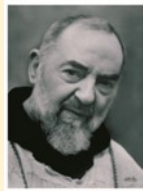

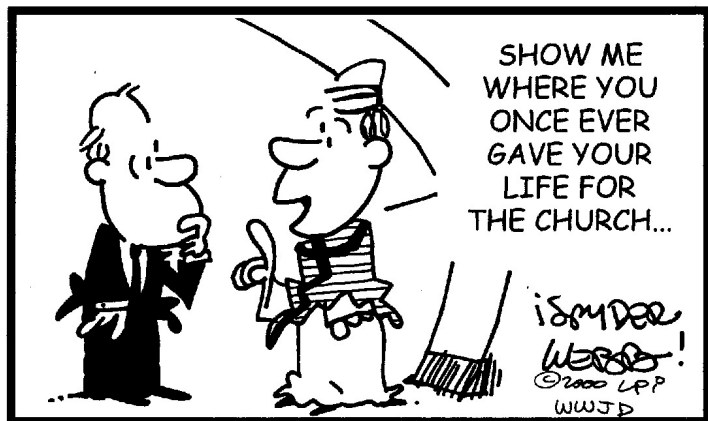
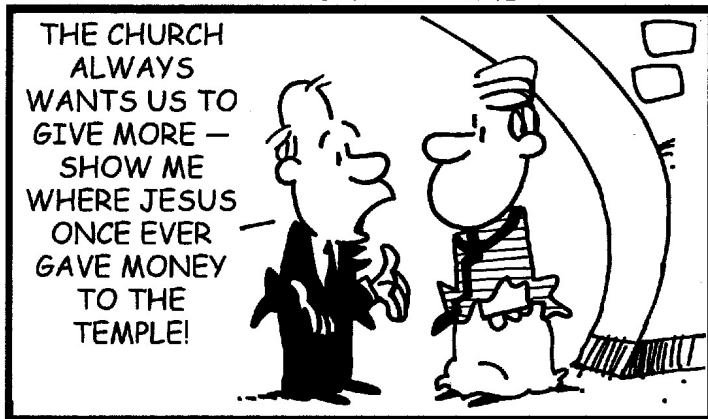
