Course Description:

In this 8 hour class the fundamentals of the pistol are developed and expanded for law enforcement personnel seeking to improve their skills and survivability. Basics of marksmanship and weapons handling build a solid foundation which evolve into speed, accuracy and effectiveness. The students will be exposed to as series of scenarios and drills that will not just develop mechanical skills but foster the ability to think and perform under stress.

Students must provide their own kit and ammo—500 rounds of pistol.

Course Objectives:

At the end of this program, students will:

- ♦ Review shooting fundamentals
- ♦ Review firearms safety
- ♦ Evaluate medical emergencies
- ♦ Work on reading how sights move after trigger breaks
- ♦ Conduct live-fire drills
- ♦ Demonstrate IAD for fail-to-fire, fail-to-eject
- ♦ Demonstrate weak-side draw and weak-side reload
- ♦ Demonstrate the use of barricades
- ♦ Demonstrate the proper techniques for shoot/move

Who Should Attend:

- ♦ Law enforcement officers
- ♦ SWAT officers

Rich Saito is assigned full-time to a SWAT team in Florida and to the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force. He has over ten years of SWAT experience in over 1000 tactical operations. Rich is currently a sniper team leader and SWAT training coordinator.
