Happy April! The year has been truly flying by! Just a note to let you all know that HVE will be participating in the GenTX- Education, GO Get It Week, April 22nd-26th! This state-wide event was designed to emphasize the importance of higher education to students at all grade levels. There will be more info coming your way in Tuesday Newsday folders!

This month we are focusing on personal safety! Students are learning to check with trusted adults before making decisions to ensure their safety. We will be discussing the differences between secrets and surprises, learning/reviewing the No > Go > Tell rule, being the boss of your own body, and practicing basic safety rules. In addition, we will relate this topic back to peer pressure and how to handle when your gut feeling says you are uncomfortable or unsafe. Discussing and role-playing ways that best fit your family needs for these types of situations will certainly help them to feel confident and prepared if/when they find themselves in these circumstances. Sharing your own experience, validating their feelings, and expressing empathy will help to encourage your child to make the best choices.
