### **Old Store Won't Rest in Peace 100 years of leftovers from T.J. Beggs & Co. pack Madison Museum**

It was one generation's junk. The grist for another's museum. From a stack of Gay '90s corsets to the paraphernalia of North Florida's first licensed embalmer, the odds and ends of T.J. Beggs & Co.'s 100-year-old general store and funeral parlor have been gathered together in a mini-museum to celebrate the store's centennial – as well as attract customers for this weekend's centennial sale. Some stained with age, some in their original packing crates; the potpourri of items on display offered a unique peek into the mercantile enterprises of a family whose history probably belongs in the yellow pages. "Some people might look at this stuff as junk," said Tommy Beggs, 55, a third generation funeral director and part-owner of the store. "For some time, I did too."

It was in 1886 when T.J. Beggs, Sr. hung his sign over a combination furniture, clothing and casket shop that he purchased from his wife's father. Thirty years later, T. J. Beggs Jr., became the area's first licensed embalmer. At one time or another, father and son catered to both the here and the hereafter in such diverse fields as dry goods, men's and women's wear, fuel oil, tobacco and tombstones. In the process, they also managed to accumulate a most eclectic collection of unsold or outdated items. And, like Fibber McGee's famous closet, the store attic became their last resting place.

Included in the museum displays were a healthy slice of leftovers from most of the Beggs enterprises – past and present. A group of wasp-waisted mannequins and stacks of Madame Lyra and American Lady corsets covered one table. Hand-carved mantelpieces and a pecan bestead with its \$16.50 price tag leaned against a wall. A rack of men's clothing featured Curlee suits, Stetson hats and Florsheim shoes. A turn-of-the-century billiard table supported ladies' high-button shoes and scratchy wool bathing suits. Farther on was a 1912 Oliver typewriter. A box for sorting tobacco leaves. Ledger books

and a roll-top desk that dated to W. A. Parramore, the original owner.

In a separate garage out back, Beggs revealed a 1919 Dodge hearse, badly in need of repairs but said to be one of the first two motorized hearses in North Florida. "It came all the way from St. Louis in a crate," he said. "My father had to have it put together before they could use it." Beggs said an anonymous buyer offered him \$10,000 for the hearse, sight unseen. But it was to the far end of the museum – where the caskets and burial shrouds beckoned – that this visitor was drawn.

Tommy Beggs and his two brothers – Ashley, 53, and Billy, 52 – operate the family funeral business in a mortuary one block away. Originally, however, embalming, casket-making and other burial services were performed at the general store. "My father was the first licensed embalmer in this area," Tommy Beggs said. "His state funeral director's license was No. 12."

In memory of that trade, a box of faded white embalming coats with the letter "B" inscribed on their breast pockets lay on a table. Nearby were women's silk and lace burial shrouds, along with a man's suit that buttoned up the back. Wooden crates labeled "CAVOS Cavity Fluid" littered the aisles. Several were stuffed with rubber tubing, metal syringes, surgeon's razors and some suspiciously stained porcelain bowls. Others held coffin fittings – silver- and brass-plated handles, figurines and plaques that read "At Rest," "Father" and "In Heaven." Along the next aisle, mummy-shaped caskets- both home-crafted and imported from Europe-were laid out on their original packing crates. A handsome brown model featured a front panel that slid back for a glassed-in view. Others, offered horseshoe-shaped lids that lifted away like toilet seats to reveal a head-only visitation. "There was usually a little net, to keep flies away," Beggs explained in somber tones. "You have to remember, that was before all these modern conveniences, like window screens and air conditioning. People had to make do."

For many years, T.J. Beggs, Jr., in Madison, was the only embalmer between

Tallahassee and Jacksonville. To serve his far-flung clientele, Tommy Beggs said, his father would take a leather satchel of tools in one hand and a folded-up cooling board in the other. Then, Beggs said, he'd "Just hop on the train and be gone." Both satchel and cooling boards were on display in the museum, along with a tin-lined box and drain plug for packing the deceased in ice and two wicker baskets to transport them to the embalming room.

"We've never had a racial problem in this field," Beggs said. "Black and white funeral homes – we've always done embalming for both." But bodies were picked up in separate baskets, he conceded. One for blacks, the other for whites. Even if, in the end, they would end up on the same table.

Full-time funeral directors now, the Beggs brothers have hired a manager for the family store. "We're too busy with our own customers," Tommy Beggs explained, noting that a funeral was scheduled shortly. Probably the only reason the store remained open, he said, was because their father insisted. "When Daddy retired, he told us he'd deed it over only if we agreed to keep it as a general store as long as he lived," Beggs said. "He's 91. And the store's still here." *[Extracted from the Tallahassee Democrat, Sunday, Nov. 2, 1986]*

### **T. J. Beggs Funeral Home of Madison, FL**

Was founded in 1886 by Thomas John Beggs, Sr.; however, it dates back to the mid 1800s when the business was owned by the founder's father-in-law, W.L. Parramore. Thomas John Beggs, Sr., bought half interest in the firm in 1886 from the original owner, W. L. Parramore, who was a dealer in furniture, clothing and coffins. The original business was located on Base Street in Madison, Florida, but in 1895 was moved to South Range Street west of the Court House in Madison, Florida, in a new building built by C.B. Ashley, son-in-law of W. L. Parramore. The funeral and mercantile business operated under one roof through wars, depressions, good and bad times. In

1953, a modern funeral home was built on N. Orange Street in Madison, FL.

Mr. T. J. Beggs, Sr., founder, was the sole owner after the death of W.L. Parramore, and remained owner until his death in 1933. After his death Thomas John Beggs, Jr. and his wife, Frances Wadsworth Beggs, became the owners.

T. J. Beggs, Jr. received his education in Madison High School, attended the Citadel in Charleston, SC and graduated from Cincinnati College of Embalming in 1916. T. J. Beggs, Jr. was a member of the firm since a young boy except for his military duties during WWI. After the war, he returned to the firm as a junior partner and remained such until the death of his father in 1933 at which time he became sole owner.

Since the founding of the business in 1886, the chief objective of all owners was to improve service and facilities to the public. After WWI, the first automotive equipment was added to the firm, which also served surrounding counties between Tallahassee, Florida and Lake City, Florida for a number of years. T. J. Beggs, Jr. was at one time the only licensed embalmer in adjoining counties, and therefore was called for long distances to embalm until other embalmers were located in these areas. Horse-drawn hearses were originally used in the firm and in 1919 a Dodge Hearse, Henney Body and sold by Williams Auto-Carriage Company of St. Louis, Missouri was added to the business, which was one of the first motor hearses in Florida.

In 1953, the T.J. Beggs, Jr. Funeral Home was moved to its new and modern building on North Orange Street, Madison, FL. The new building was of red brick and built along modern conservative lines, air-conditioned, wall-to-wall carpet, a Chapel seating 300 persons, a private family room and modern automotive equipment.

The owners when they transitioned to a professional association were T. J. Beggs, Jr., and his three sons, Thomas John Beggs, III, Ashley Parramore Beggs, and William Turner Beggs. Thomas John Beggs, III, a graduate of Cincinnati College of Embalming, and a graduate of Emory University. Ashley

Parramore Beggs attended the University of Florida, North Florida Junior College and the Dallas Institute of Mortuary Science. William Turner Beggs, graduate of Emory University and Dallas Institute of Mortuary Science.

In 1957, the firm was invited to become members of the National Selected Morticians. In 1967 the Beggs Horry Street Chapel was opened and in 1975 the firm acquired the Wilkins Funeral Home in Monticello, Florida. Other businesses included North Florida Wilbert Vault Service and Beggs Monument Company.

Funeral Directors associated with the firm were Ashley P. Beggs, Jr., Allen Kyle Beggs, and Russell M. Newsome. The firm was a member of the National Funeral Directors Association; the Florida Funeral Directors Association; Big Bend Funeral Directors Association and National Selected Morticians.

### **ARCHIE BEGGS**

After four weeks of intense suffering Mr. Archie Beggs, a beloved and life-long resident of this county, passed away last Thursday afternoon at his home one mile south of town. His funeral was held at Oakland Cemetery Friday morning, the services being touchingly conducted by Dr. Mickle of the Presbyterian church. The funeral was largely attended by the relatives of the deceased and the family friends. He is survived by his wife, his aged mother, Mrs. Americus Beggs; one brother and two sisters, Charles Beggs, Mrs. E. S. Armstrong, and Mrs. J. P. Pillins, and three children, Stewart Beggs of Valdosta, Mrs. A. N. Hubbard of Mt. Pleasant, and Mrs. Fletcher of Havana, all of whom lovingly attended him in his final illness.

Mrs. Beggs leaves one son, C. F. Beggs, and two daughters, Mrs. J. C. Pillans of Electra, Fla., and Mrs. E. S. Armstrong, besides a number of grandchildren, great grandchildren, and other relatives and friends to mourn her loss.

The body was laid to rest at Oakland Cemetery, of which the church the deceased was a member, Saturday afternoon, Rev. W. S. Patterson conducting the services.

### **DEATH CLAIMS T. J. BEGGS, SR., PROMINENT MADISON BUSINESS MAN**

Mr. T. J. Beggs, Sr., prominent in the business and social life of Madison for the past fifty years or more, passed away Wednesday evening at 6:30 o'clock, following a lingering illness of two or more years.

Thomas John Beggs was born in Madison, November 10, 1863. He was the son of John M. and Ann Dunbar Beggs, pioneers of this county. He was married in 1890 to Miss Helen Parramore, daughter of the late William L. Parramore and Helen Livingston Parramore.

Mr. Beggs was active in the mercantile business in this city since 1889, being a prominent factor in the business life of the community. At the time of his death he was at the head of T. J. Beggs & Company, however, his lingering illness kept him from taking an active part recently. He was an upright citizen and greatly admired for his business integrity and friendly, affable manner. He was a member of the Baptist church since early manhood and before his illness was active in the work of the church.

Mr. Beggs was greatly admired for his many fine traits of character, by his scores of

friends and devotedly loved by a large family connection. His passing away will be mourned by all who knew him.

Mr. Beggs is survived by his widow, one son, T. J. Beggs, Jr., and three daughters, Mrs. S. R. Marks of Jacksonville, Mrs. H. Crill Merryday and Mrs. W. T. Davis of this city, and eight grandchildren. Two brothers, Judge E. D. Beggs of Pensacola and Charles T. Beggs of Madison, also survive. One brother, Judge James D. Beggs, of Orlando, passed a few years ago.

Funeral services were held yesterday afternoon at 4 o'clock at the residence on North Washington Street, with committal at Oak Ridge Cemetery. Rev. Shelby A. Wilson, pastor of the First Methodist Church, officiated. The many beautiful floral offerings attested to the love and esteem in which Mr. Beggs was held by a large circle of friends and relatives.

Mr. Charles T. Beggs, prominent citizen of this community, died Wednesday, August 9, at the home of his son, Dr. John Beggs at Chattahoochee, following a several weeks' illness of a complication of heart diseases.

Charles Tutt Beggs was born in Madison County, Fla., sixty-eight years ago, August 24. He was married to Miss Walteria L. Smith of Boston, Ga., in early manhood.

Survivors are his wife, three sons, Dr. John Beggs, Chattahoochee, Col. E. Dixie Beggs, Ft. Myers, J. S. Beggs, Madison, and one daughter, Mrs. J. R. Wooten, also of

Madison. One brother, Judge E. D. Beggs of Pensacola and six grandchildren are among the survivors.

Mr. Beggs was a traveling salesman and for over thirty years traveled for Solomon Company of Savannah, Ga. For the past several years he has been living retired, moving to Madison from Pavo, Ga. In 1923, he built a home on North Horry Street where he resided until about a year ago, when he was overtaken by ill health and has been making his home with his children since. He was a consistent member of the Baptist church, an upright citizen and loyal friend. His passing is mourned by a large circle of friends and relatives.

The body of the deceased was brought to Madison where funeral services were held at Oak Ridge cemetery yesterday afternoon at four o'clock. The Rev. E. B. Evans, pastor of the First Baptist Church, officiated.

### **Charles F. Beggs Laid to Rest at Old Oakland**

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 5 o'clock at Old Oakland

Cemetery for Charles F. Beggs, life-time citizen of this county, who passed away early Monday morning at his home twelve miles southwest of Madison. Mr. Beggs had been ill for a long time, during a part of which his sufferings were intense, but he bore them with patience and faith in the One whom he had served so long.

Mr. Beggs was born in Madison County at the old Beggs home place Dec. 13, 1867, and was married to Miss Irene Shaw Aug. 24, 1895. No children were born to them, but they reared several, and often took the place of father and mother to many more. Indeed their home and their kindly help in so many ways was a blessing to that whole part of the county. He was affectionately known by many as "Uncle Charlie."

Mr. Beggs was a long time member, and later Elder, of the Oakland Presbyterian Church, having joined the church during Dr. Bradshaw's pastorate. He took great interest in its work, and was a faithful attendant at both the church and Sunday School services until his last illness.

At the funeral services, Rev. R. H. Lantham, his pastor for many years, spoke beautifully of his life. He was assisted in the services by Rev. J. E. Ellis of the Methodist Church. A quartet composed of Mrs. B. G. Waring, Mrs. Turner Davis, Mr. Alex Wade and Mr. Waller Whitlock sang.

## OAK RIDGE CEMETERY

Before the land was purchased from Madison Livingston, which is now known as Oak Ridge Cemetery, the dead were buried around our churches, a custom we inherited from England. Many of the old settlers were buried in the Methodist and Baptist church yards. Later a few bodies were removed from both spots and reinterred in Oak Ridge. A man has been heard to say that he felt nearer to his mother in the Baptist church yard than elsewhere because there was so little found of her remains when moved to Oak Ridge.

Gray's Elegy was no doubt suggested to the author's mind by a neglected church yard. It is known as one of the finest poems in our language. It was one of our own Southern writers who exclaimed, "O desolation, thy name is a country grave yard." The people of Madison owe a debt of gratitude to the Woman's Association for the work done in our cemetery. Out of great disorder and chaotic rubbish, there has come a measure of neatness and some order but much more work is required before the desired effect is accomplished. "God's acre" is a subject so sacred that it appeals to every heart, and there is not a family in Madison that has not some loved ones sleeping in their "windowless homes."

Both art and nature has had a share in making this place of sepulture beautiful. It is an evidence of a cultured and refined community to have a neat and well kept cemetery. In Oak Ridge there bloom many flowers in their season, and the many trees hanging with moss add enchantment to the scene of this sacred shrine. To those who love rural beauty the sequestered shade of Oak Ridge will have an indescribable fascination, as the spirit of loved ones seem nearer to us, those who in a better land are watching and waiting for our coming.

There repose all that was mortal of many who have been sleeping here so many years that even their names are forgotten. There are many brave soldiers buried here, who "wore the gray" in the sixties. History will write their names in letters of untarnished gold.

In some enclosures there sleep men whose lives ended in a tragedy. A school teacher was killed by one of his scholars and here sleeps a young man killed by his best friend, indeed there are a number of men who met untimely and sudden deaths. One evening in the long ago, just at tea time, there rang out several shots. Two men had been instantly ushered into eternity without warning. There were prominent citizens and brothers-in-law. Among the tragedies, there are four who laid violent hands on their own lives. One of them was a young and capable physician. Another one was a music teacher who drowned himself for the love of a beautiful but vain coquette.

There sleep in Oak Ridge some physicians who were of the old school like William MacLurre of the "Bonnie Brier Bush," who were merciful and kind, and answered every call that came at all hours day and night. Those remembered are Doctors Shaffer, Treadwell, Burton, Fearnside, Brinson, Paterson, Pope and Sessions. There are lawyers sleeping in Oak Ridge who were men of intelligence and great learning, B. C. Pope, O. U. Lee, Alex McDonald, D. H. Mays, Hunter Pope, Angus and Frank Paterson, C. B. Ashley and E. J. Vann. The ministers who rest here were faithful Pastors who read the services over the graves of saints and sinners alike, who carried peace and comfort to many bereaved hearts in times of affliction. These faithful men were W. L. Kennedy, J. J. Richard, P. U. McKay, A. A. Barnett and James Howland. There rest some noted educators in this cemetery, Cannon H. Shipp, James L. Moseley, Hugh Morrow and Mr. Bristow. As far as known there are only three Hebrews who rest in this cemetery.

The first man laid to rest in Oak Ridge was Major Thomas who was killed by his horses running away, while driving near the residence of Mr. Archibald Fair. A great granddaughter of Mr. Fair is one of the women who is an active member of the cemetery association. There are many men and women of every vocation of life, who rest in this cemetery who have left honored names to their descendants, reminding us that it matters not, how "a person dies, but how he lives." As one walks in Oak Ridge, memory turns with lingering regret, as they recall the loving tones of sweet voices now hushed in death. Heaven comes nearer and grows more attractive as one thinks of loved ones who dwell there. But: "There is no death; The stars go down, To Rise upon some fairer shore, And bright in Heaven's jeweled crown, They shine for ever more." Old Timer.

- After he left office, Sheriff John H. Patterson of Madison County was repaid \$52 for hiring extra bailiffs under orders from a circuit judge.
- Madison County's Edward Vann was captured while on picket duty at Petersburg, Virginia. The ex-sheriff was sent to Point Lookout prison in Maryland where he succumbed on October 26, 1864.
- Madison County Sheriff David Montgomery was one of seven African-American sheriffs who served during the Reconstruction. David Montgomery, a New York-born mulatto with a talent for baseball, served as Madison County Sheriff from 1868-1873. It was a time of rampant crime. In 1870, he was nearly assassinated by a group of masked men. Active in politics, Montgomery also represented Madison County in the Florida House of Representatives. In 1876 he narrowly lost a contest for lieutenant governor.

### Reminiscences of Capt John L. Inglis, 1902

Sitting on the portico of the Ocala House the other night, Capt John L. Inglis grew a little reminiscent. He came from Scotland, he said, to take charge of a large machine shop at Newport for that former estimable old man, Daniel Ladd. He remembered reaching Valdosta and going by stage to Madison and from the latter place to Newport by private conveyance. Valdosta was being laid out; the trees were being cut down and the trash and timber piled and burned. There were only one or two houses in the place and they were built of logs. But when Capt. Ingles reached Newport (FL), he saw a busy, bustling city built of brick and mortar, and which was noted scarcely less for its fine residences than for its commercial prosperity. The harbor was crowded with masts. It was the shipping point for merchants and farmers almost as far into Georgia as Sunbury and easily measured strength with Pensacola and Mobile. There is not now a building, pier, wall, chimney, or a brick to tell where the city stood. Newport has been wiped entirely off the map, and is planted to cotton and corn. On the contrary, Valdosta has grown into a city as large as Newport was at that time. Capt Inglis was then a full-grown man and is yet not an old man, but has witnessed many changes.
