AMMENDED RULES
The 4-H Rodeo Rule Book will be used. The following are amended rules for this <i>Unsanctioned 4-H</i> event:

Team Roping: Points and payback are awarded only to the entrant. PICK partner must be a contestant in rodeo and can be from 7-9, 10-13 or 14-18 age group. DRAW partner will drawn from team roping entrants in rodeo from 7-9, 10-13 or 14-18 age group. Cattle will not be drawn, but chute ran.

Roping & Goat Tying Stock will NOT be drawn, but chute ran and chosen to be most fitting to age group.

Age groups: A contestant may enter his or her current age group or enter "up" to older age group.

Ground money: No ground money awarded in any event.

Alley way is considered part of the arena for speed events.

Late entries for stocked events will be accepted only if there is enough stock to accommodate the number of contestants.
Roping, goat tying, rough stock event late entries are first up in age group.
Speed event late entries go last in age group.
