## President's Message

We have received a couple of letters regarding the format and tee selections in the Saturday skins game. We appreciate the input from the membership. The Board of Directors met and had lengthy discussions regarding your concerns. Keeping in mind that we can't satisfy everyone, we have come up with a new format that should address most members concerns.

Instead of splitting the field in half to determine what group you will be in "A" or " B ", the groups will be determined by your handicap. Handicaps between 0 and 10 will be in the " A " group and will play from the blue tees on both courses. Handicaps between 11 and 20 will be in the " $B$ " group and will play from the white tees on both courses. The groups may not be even and how many players in each group will determine the payouts.

The closest to the pin will pay $\$ 15$ on each par three in both groups (one winner per flight) and will be played from their respective tees (no more putting the tees together). The closest to the pin money will come out of the pot first and then the skins will be split between "A" and "B" groups according to the number of players in each group.

The Board of Directors feel that this will resolve issues regarding competitiveness, knowing exactly what tees that you will play, what group that you will be competing in, and overall have a fun round of golf.

I would like to encourage every member to take advantage of the communication aspect of the new EPMC Web Site (elpradomensclub.com) and can ensure that any issues that you bring to our attention will be addressed in the monthly board meeting. ## Rule 6-6 Scoring in stroke play

a. Recording Scores

After each hole the marker should check the score with the competitor and record it. On completion of the round the marker must sign the scorecard and hand it to the competitor. If more than one marker records the scores, each must sign for the part for which he is responsible. b. Signing and Returning Scorecard

After completion of the round, the competitor should check his score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with the committee. He must ensure that the marker or markers have signed the scorecard, sign the scorecard himself and return it to the committee as soon as possible.

## PENALTY FOR BREACH OF RULE 6-6B:

DISQUALIFICATION.
C. Alteration of scorecard

No alteration of may be made on a scorecard after the competitor has returned it to the committee. d. Wrong score for hole

The competitor is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole of his scorecard. If he returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken, he is disqualified. If he returns a score that is higher than actually taken, the score as returned stands.

The team score on each hole is the designated "Red Ball" player's net score plus the best net score of the other three players.
