

Viewing SCOPIA® Desktop User Interface

On 4K Resolution Computer Monitors (Windows Platform)

The purpose of the steps outlined below is to show you a work around for the scaling problem that makes windows too small to view on 4K resolution monitors.

- Join a SCOPIA® Meeting on your computer
- 2. You will see that your SCOPIA® Meeting Interface looks very small in all windows except the video window.



- 3. Make sure the SCOPIA® User Interface windows are active by clicking on the SCOPIA® icon the task bar are where the open applications are located.
- The SCOPIA® Desktop Meeting User interface will appear in the foreground blocking all other applications from view.
- 5. You may maximize the SCOPIA® User Interface by to cover the entire desktop by clicking the *Maximize* button



- 6. Use your computer keyboard to do the following:
 - a. Computers with Number Pads: Press while pressing each time you want to make the user interface view larger
 - b. **Computers with no number pad:** Press while pressing on your keyboard to zoom in and make the SCOPIA® user interface windows larger.
