## PLAYER/PARENT AGREEMENT FOR 2013

As a parent it is your responsibility to make sure both you and your son or daughter are committed to the program and their team. This may mean a sacrifice for both parent and player! Parents are expected to work at tournaments that Tennessee Xtreme host. Money raised helps offset miscellaneous expenses and tournament fees.

Practices are mandatory and important to both player and team. You, as a parent, need to get your child to practice every time and be on time! It is the player's responsibility to inform the Coach if she is going to be late or miss a practice or game. This is a **MUST!** Please let the coach know as soon as you know. Too many unexcused practices or missed games can be cause for dismissal from the team (coach's discretion).

You can not allow outside distractions to interfere with that the team is trying to accomplish through hard work at practice. The focus of the team is to provide all players the opportunity to develop and improve their skill and play competitive basketball against other players of equal or higher skills. This will hopefully give our players exposure and perhaps help them to have successful high school and college careers. They will get to travel and make new friends, but most of all, have fun.

As a parent, you must refrain from coaching your child while at games. This only distracts the player and confuses them. A player shouldn't be put in the position of whom to listen to while on the floor – the coach or the parent. Parents need to be positive at all times, to their son and daughter and all their teammates.

If you have any questions or issues regarding your son or daughter or the team, please see the coach after practice once the players have been dismissed or call them at home. These fees are nonrefundable and include the use of a uniform, AAU card, YBOA card, AAU State, and YBOA Sub-State entry as well as tournament entry fees for each player's team. **Discounts are available for multiple girls in the same family and we have sponsorship letters available for players that may have difficulty with their fees. (See Coach of Team).** **This Player fee is due by March 30<sup>th</sup> or sooner.**

All uniforms are the property of Tennessee Xtreme and should be turned in to your coach at the last game of the season. If a player decides to leave the team on her own or is asked to leave the team for disciplinary reasons by a member of the coaching staff the return policy for the uniform is immediately.

**If a uniform is lost or returned in poor condition then the parent will be charged a replacement fee.**
