West Erie Two/Three Board meeting October 7, 2019 at St. James starting at 6:30 PM

All Board members were present.

The representatives of each congregation gave positive feedback followed by the pastoral staff who also feel things are going well.

Deacon Nancy told us that churches have the option to pay an employee's full FICA and Social Security.

A discussion of budget numbers followed doing an A option for half FICA and SS as well as a B option with full FICA and SS.

The figures for pulpit supply, book allowance, travel and expenses, and an office manager were then figured along with the yearly worker's compensation premium.

The new member giving unit numbers that will be used until January are: Immanuel 42.5% St. James 20.8% St. John 36.7%.

Ann Sawin moved, with second by David Olson, that we recommend to the respective councils the full B option. Motion passed with 9 yays, one no. Discussion followed including information that both staff members work more hours than they are paid for. Each council is to email the results of their council's vote as soon as it occurs.

David Olson will email the Option B budget figures.

For the next meeting, each church is to choose its top three options for a job description.

Adjournment was at 8:20 PM.

Next meeting will be Monday, October 21, 2019 at St. James starting at 6:30PM.


