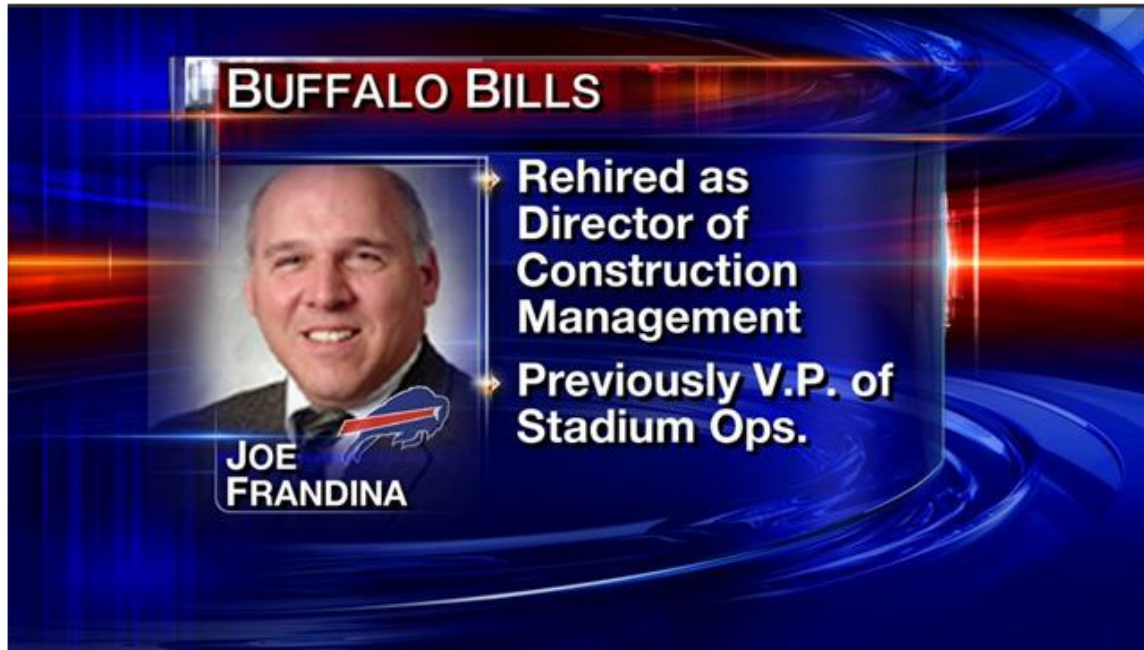

BUFFALO, N.Y. -- You might not think news that the [Buffalo Bills](#) are re-hiring a construction manager is a big deal.

But that news signals that the team is ready to begin moving forward with [improvements to Ralph Wilson Stadium](#) that could keep the team here.

The Bills announced Wednesday they've rehired Joe Frandina as Director of Construction Management. He was the team's Vice-President of Stadium Operations until he retired in 2010.

The Bills say Frandina will oversee and manage all aspects of the team's long-range stadium improvement planning.

A review process is underway to determine what renovations are necessary at the stadium. The team's lease with Erie County expires next year.
