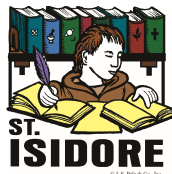

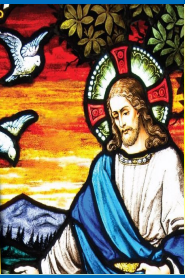

May 14-St. Matthias—Chosen by lot to replace Judas Iscariot, St. Matthias first preached the Gospel in Judea and Aethiopia, where he was stoned to death .

May 15-St. Isidore—The patron saint of farmers and laborers, St. Isidore had deep religious instincts and was know for his love of the poor and concern for the proper treatment of animals.

May 18-St. John II—Pope from 533 to 535, St. John II was the first to take a different name upon being elevated to the position of Pope, as he was given the pagan name of Mercurius at birth. He adopted the name of Pope John II after Pope John I, who was venerated as a martyr.

13 de mayo de 2018 • La Ascensión del Señor

La celebración de la Ascensión es una oportunidad para considerar qué es lo que pensamos del cielo, y también lo que pensamos acerca de la Tierra. Ambos son la creación de Dios. ¿Qué es lo que te pasa por la mente cuando piensas en el cielo? El cielo ha sido representado tanto por cristianos y por otras personas. Estas representaciones están tan lejos de lo que las Escrituras nos describen. En la Biblia, es todo menos un lugar a donde uno va después de la muerte, sino más el espacio donde Dios interactúa con la creación física, la cual es descrita como la "Tierra". El cielo es muy diferente de la Tierra, sin embargo, muy cercano a la Tierra.

La Ascensión nos enseña que el cielo se entrelaza con la Tierra más completamente en Jesús, quien es tanto divino como humano. Cuando él asciende, Jesús empieza su reino en el cielo y en la Tierra. También escuchamos la promesa del regreso de Jesús, cuando su reinado se llevará a cabo. El cielo y la Tierra serán totalmente renovados, transformados y unidos en una nueva manera.

ESPERANDO EN EL ESPÍRITU

Después de haber recibido las instrucciones finales de Jesús, y haberlo visto elevarse al cielo, a sus discípulos también

se les dijo que esperaran. Jesús había prometido que pronto serían bautizados por el Espíritu Santo (en Pentecostés), sino ahora ellos mismos deben esperar y prepararse. Juntos con la última espera para el regreso de Jesús, ellos también necesitan aprender a esperar en las pequeñas cosas. Ellos esperaron el Espíritu para que los empoderara y guiara.

A menudo esperar es difícil para nosotros, la Iglesia. Tendemos a movernos rápido, a querer tomar decisiones y llevarlas a cabo. Algunas veces llegamos a la conclusión que tenemos buenas ideas y planes que harán una diferencia positiva, por lo que es momento de llevarla a cabo. Pero nuestras buenas ideas no son necesariamente las ideas de Dios para nosotros en ese momento específico. A menudo, necesitamos reducir nuestra velocidad, quizá poner nuestros planes ante Dios y esperar el Espíritu. En esos momentos, estamos aprendiendo que esto es el trabajo de Dios, no nuestro. Nosotros siempre debemos recibir de Dios, y ser sostenidos por Dios, para poder compartir a Dios con otras personas.

MISSION STATEMENT

Today we celebrate Christ's ascension into heaven and his commissioning of the disciples to carry on his mission in the world. First we hear Luke's description of those events in the opening verses of the Acts of the Apostles. Next we hear words of encouragement and guidance from the Letter to the Ephesians. Finally we hear Mark's account of the Ascension, foretelling the mighty words and acts the Christian community would do in Jesus' name.

Together these scriptures give us a vision of the mission of the church of Jesus Christ—a mission statement of sorts. Like mission statements in our parishes and corporations, this mission statement can help us set priorities and focus our activities. It can guide and support us as we strive to continue Christ's messianic mission on earth.

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TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — Jesus tells the disciples that they will be witnesses to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:1-11).

Psalms — God mounts his throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord (Psalm 47).

Second Reading — God seated Jesus at his right hand in the heavens (Ephesians 1:17-23) or *Ephesians 4:1-13 [1-7, 11-13]*.

Gospel — The Lord Jesus was taken up into heaven. (Mark 16:15-20).

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In Ireland and the United Kingdom, Mother's Day is over. "Mothering Sunday" was on the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Long ago, people were freed from work to travel on this day to the parish where they were baptized, their "Mother Church." Often, people were reunited with their mothers on this day. Employers would release their workers and servants for this visit. The American celebration, while based on this custom, really has to do with an anti-war movement of mothers in Civil War times. They crusaded for better sanitary conditions for their sons. When President Wilson instituted the first Mother's Day in 1912, it was a day to fly the flag in honor of mothers whose children had died in battle. Knowing the tradition is a good balance to our celebration today. We can enfold in prayer the mothers who have suffered the loss of their children in war.

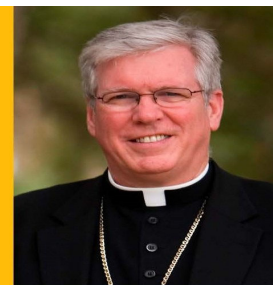

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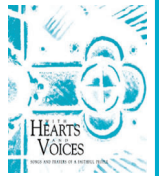

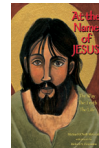
