Aggregate from the operating location noted above is approved for NYSDOT §703-01, Fine Aggregate and §703-02, Coarse Aggregate without restriction. This letter supersedes the letter dated April 24, 2019 and removes the provisional status and the restriction against use in Portland cement concrete applications. The requirements of Materials Method 29 (MM29), issued July 2007, have been met.

Aggregate sources which satisfy all applicable requirements of MM29 will appear on the [Approved List of Sources of Fine and Coarse Aggregate](#). The Approved List is maintained and updated to reflect current source approval status. Approval status is maintained by routine testing to confirm compliance with NYSDOT specifications, and adherence to the requirements of MM29. If physical testing, geologic, or administrative issues indicate the approval status should be modified, the source approval status may be modified and notification will be made to the producer and reflected on the internet published Approved List.

Please note this letter only documents the approval status of this source effective on the date of this letter. The Approved List published on the Department's website should be relied upon for current source approval status. The Regional Materials Engineer and/or the Materials Bureau, Engineering Geology Section can also provide current source approval status.
