Like last time we will have 12 and under, and 13 and older prizes for both boys and girls. Please be sure to bring along archery and fishing equipment if you can. We will provide .22 rifles, ammo, targets, bait, and LUNCH.

IWLA Family Picnic: Family Picnic – The family picnic is one of our clubs finest traditions and you, and your family, are invited to attend. You may extend this invitation to extended family as well as friends or neighbors who may be interested in joining our chapter. It will be on Sunday, August 30th. Lunch will be at noon with festivities beginning as early as 9:00 and lasting until 4:00 or later. The club will be providing pork, burgers, hot dogs, rolls and drinks. 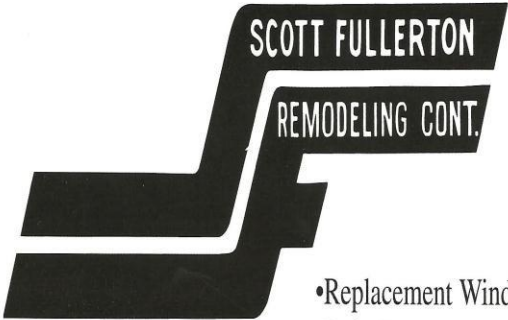
