### **AGILITY OFFERINGS**

1. Agility Skills and Drills for Levels 1 & 2 – a 7 week Monday class that will be held from 5:30 to 7:00 starting November 13. Email the instructor, Harriett Browne directly for class information or to register.
2. Agility Games and Distance for Levels 3, 4, 5 and 6 – a 6 week Monday class that will be held from 7:00 to 9:00 starting November 13. The instructors will be Crystal King and June Ritchhart. Sign up is through the agility lottery book.
