The Wisconsin Healthcare Emergency Preparedness Program, the Medical College of Wisconsin (MCW), and Aspirus Health Care are pleased to offer an Advanced Hazmat Life Support (AHLS) Provider course.

AHLS Provider course is a 16-hour two-day course that teaches healthcare professionals to medically manage patients exposed to hazardous materials, including chemical, biological and radiological incidents. Participants learn to recognize signs and symptoms of exposure from corrosives, irritant gases, asphyxiants, hydrocarbons, substituted hydrocarbons, chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear agents. Specific antidotes, their indications, and contraindications are also covered. By the end of the course the student will be able to rapidly assess HAZMAT patients, recognize toxidromes, discuss the medical management of HAZMAT patients, apply the Poisoning Treatment Paradigm™, and identify and recognize appropriate administration of specific antidotes. This course provides medical providers with a 4 year certification.
