This quarter's story by Marjorie:

My family friend, whom I've known for many years, has heard the myriad stories of communication challenges faced by my daughter, Chloe. This summer Chloe attended a science camp on the east coast that necessitated her first unaccompanied air travel including a plane change. I shared with my friend all the anxiety I felt about changing planes in what many consider the busiest airport in the US and how was it going to work out??? (Note: It went fine! Months later, my friend was traveling through the Atlanta Airport herself and barely heard her departure gate change over the loudspeaker. Fifteen minutes later she noticed that the departure board still had the old gate listed. Realizing that this was exactly the crisis I had feared and predicted, she went to the nearest gate agent and told them "you have to change the listing immediately! There are deaf and hard of hearing travelers that rely on this information!"
