Friday Nov 8, 2019	Announcement of vacancies and timelines to members via AVUTA email, website, and site postings
Friday Dec 6, 2019	Declarations of candidacy must be received by the election committee chair by filling out online at https://goo.gl/forms/Md5dvO7swadkCueQ2 , via email at avuta.elections@gmail.com , or by dropping it off at Apple Valley High School to the mailbox of Jessica Cooley no later than 4:00 pm on Dec. 6, 2019.
Monday Dec 9, 2019	Acknowledgement of declarations of candidacy.
Friday Dec 6, 2019	Candidate statements must be received by the election committee chair via email, avuta.elections@gmail.com by 4:00 pm (Candidate statements must not exceed 250 words, all candidates will be treated identically) on Friday, Dec 6, 2019.
Tues Dec 10, 2019	Preparation of campaign statements, ballots and voter registration roster/sign-in sheets.
Weds Dec 11, 2019	Voting will be available online - notifications will be sent out by Weds Dec. 11, 2019.
Mon Dec 16, 2019	All ballots must be cast by Monday, Dec 16, 2019 at midnight.
Weds Dec 18, 2019	Ballots will be counted by Intelliscan and reported to AVUTA's President and Secretary by Wednesday, Dec. 18, 2019.
Fri Dec 20, 2019	Announcement of results to AVUTA members on the AVUTA website, www.avuta.us and via site representatives. Results shall be posted at each school site no later than five (5) calendar days following the counting of the ballots. If a runoff election is necessary, this will be included in the announcement.
Mon Jan 7, 2020	Preparation of run-off ballots, if necessary .

<p>Fri Jan 17, 2020</p>	<p>Announcement of results to AVUTA members on the AVUTA website, www.avuta.us and via site representatives. Results shall be posted no later than five (5) calendar days following the counting of the ballots. If a runoff election is necessary, this will be included in the announcement.</p>
