

- 6-14 oz. pump spray insect repellent (pack of 10-20 wipes also acceptable)
  - Pump spray bottles must have protective covers
- Scrub brush
  - With or without handle
- Re-use cleaning wipes
  - No terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels
- Scouring pads sponges
  - No stainless steel pads with soap in them
- Clothespins
- 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic line)
- 24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon sizes)
- N95 particulate respirator dust masks (1-3 mm thickness)
  - No surgical masks
- Kitchen gloves
  - Durable for multiple uses
- Work gloves
  - Cotton with leather palm or all leather
