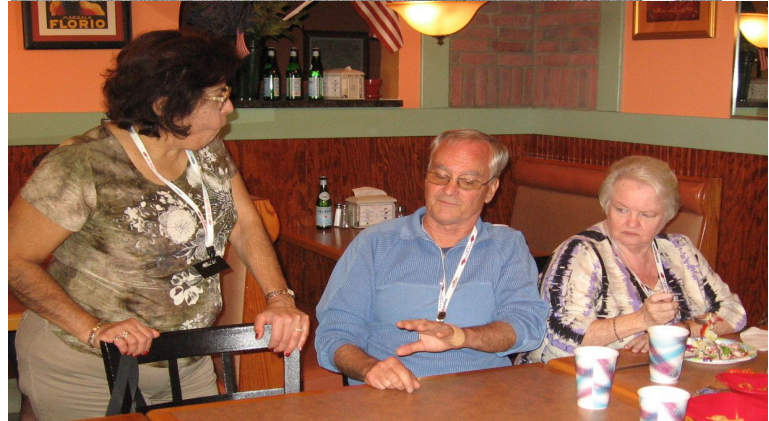
Holiday Party - Date Change

Rich Martin rolled over his race car at the track last weekend. Car is totaled, but the best news is that Rich is ok, thank god.

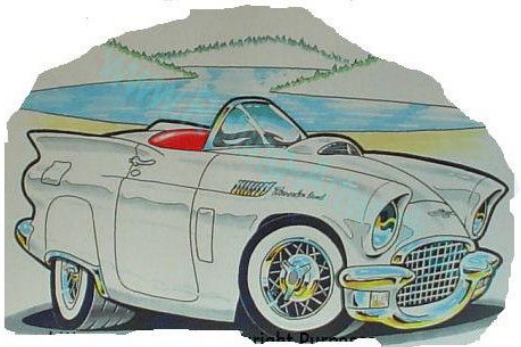
