How many times has a melody touched your mind, your heart and created a profound sense of peace or joy? How many times have simple words uniquely expressed reached you in an inexplicably innate way? How many times have colors on canvas taken your breath away, caused you to pause and really think?

This installation is an expression of cultural cohesion, of showing how we can coexist within our distinct values and ways of life yet become a part of this massive mosaic of otherness.

Through acrylics, craft & design, spoken word, and music we will show how we can and do coexist. And we ask you to consider in a manner that transcends discursive thought the unlimited possibilities of how accepting others will open new doors to peace.




