The third Friday in October each year is National Mammography Day, first proclaimed by President Clinton in 1993. On this day, or throughout the month, women are encouraged to make a mammography appointment.

In 2018, National Mammography Day will be celebrated on October 19. Please contact your doctor to set up your appointment today.

A hot lunch is served daily from 11:30am to 12:30pm. Reservations are required at least 24 hours in advance.



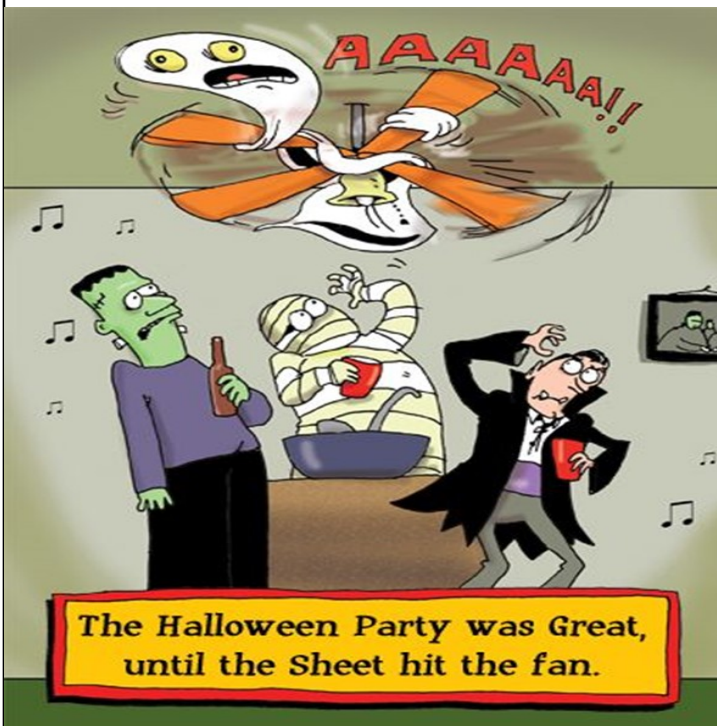
TRANSPORTATION


