**First Lesson Isaiah 43:14-**21 <u>14</u> Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: "For your sake I send to Babylon and bring them all down as fugitives, even the Chaldeans, in the ships in which they rejoice. <u>15</u> I am the LORD, your Holy One, the Creator of Israel, your King." <u>16</u> Thus says the LORD, who makes a way in the sea, a path in the mighty waters, <u>17</u> who brings forth chariot and horse, army and warrior; they lie down, they cannot rise, they are extinguished, quenched like a wick: <u>18</u> "Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. <u>19</u> Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the yilderness and rivers in the desert. <u>20</u> The wild beasts will honor me, the jackals and the ostriches, for I give water in the wilderness, rivers in the desert, to give drink to my chosen people, <u>21</u> the people whom I formed for myself that they might declare my praise.

Second Lesson Romans 3:19-28 19 Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God.20 For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.21 But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it--22 the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins.26 It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.27 Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith.28 For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.

**Gospel** John 8:31-36 <u>31</u> So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples,<u>32</u> and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."<u>33</u> They answered him, "We are offspring of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How is it that you say, 'You will become free'?"<u>34</u> Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is a slave to sin. <u>35</u> The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever.<u>36</u> So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.


