## The following are rules for the auction.

- 1. All rabbits must be purebred and have a COMPLETE pedigree at time of sale. This means that all weights, color, tattoo numbers etc. must be for each rabbit on the pedigree.
- 2. Every rabbit will be examined by a judge or registrar to meet breed requirements as per ARBA Standard of Perfection. The rabbit must be free of disqualifications, illness, or injury and the examiner has the right to reject the animal if the above is not met.
- 3. All rabbits in the auction will have a legible ear tattoo as per ARBA rules.
- 4. There will be opportunity for buyers to review the rabbit and pedigree before the auction begins.
- 5. Owner will place a starting bid on the rabbit attached to the pedigree.
- 6. Rabbit with pedigree must be checked in by noon Saturday, April 22.
- 7. Adults and youth are eligible to bid on rabbits.

As of 4/3/2017, a trio of Czech Frosties, a pair of Himalayans, at least one Rex as well as either a Champagne D'Argent or a Rhinelander has been donated to this worthy cause. Thank you WCRBA for hosting this auction.
