A remembrance service will be held at St Leonard's starting at 10:45am and wreaths will be laid at the War Memorial at the end of the service.

There will be no remembrance service at St Mark's Church this year. We will hold a short service at the **War Memorial from 10:45am** on the 11th which will include the laying of wreaths.
