Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by LOQW, INC, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with LOQW, INC:

- A Title VI Complaint Form may be obtained by down loading from the agency web page at <u>www.loqw.com</u> or by calling the individual offices which provide the service delivery. - In addition to the complaint process at LOQW, Inc., complaints may also be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region VII, Office of Civil Rights, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE, Washington, DC 20590.
- Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
