

Below is a quick summary on the work that will be taking place on Route 31.

The NJDOT has awarded a contract to Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc., to complete resurfacing work on Route 31. The work is expected to start on July 20, 2020, and will consist of select pavement repairs and the application of a slurry seal to the existing roadway surface. This resurfacing will not raise the surface more than 3/8" and is more of a preventative treatment than a roadway reconstruction method. The project will begin in the Town of Clinton near the intersection of Grayrock Road and end in Washington Township at the intersection of South Lincoln Avenue/Hawk Pointe Blvd. The NJDOT has not indicated how long they expect the project to last, however, the contract specifies a completion date of September 8, 2020. Once we find out more information from the NJDOT, we will update this notice.
