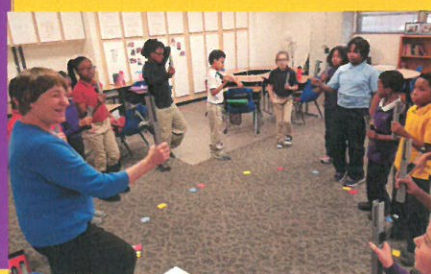
PIANO LESSONS AT ICS
