Since 2005, over 177,000 New Shoes have been provided to low income, disadvantaged children in SW Florida.



Working to Empower tomorrow's Generations Today. Reaching out to at-risk kids with after school tutoring, mentoring, and character development, lifting the environment of poverty, academic failure, & hopelessness, in the shadows of our local communities.



Provides local children with access to psychiatrists, psychologists & mental health resources. They advocate, raise awareness and support kids with mental & behavioral issues.



Supports active duty servicemen/women with quick medical access for PTSD treatments as well as supply much needed R&R for Active Combat Servicemen.



Helping our own employees or their children with education grants to encourage a higher level of education.



Gives physically and mentally challenged young adults a chance to be part of a team, and turn their challenges into success stories.



Estero non-profit group provides financial travel aid for non-life threatening, yet debilitating medical conditions. Financial assistance is offered to ensure no child is denied access to specialized medical attention due to travel expenses.
