TEMPLETON STUDENT HONORED WITH GOOD CITIZEN AWARD

In a very touching ceremony Tuesday night (May 7), Templeton Fire Chief Bill White presented local student Josh Englant with a Good Citizen Award for his heroic effort in reporting a possible fire.

Noticing smoke coming from a neighbor's house, Josh immediately reported it to his mom who called 911. Fire crews were dispatched and discovered smoke alarms had been activated. Food left on the stove was causing a great deal of smoke.

Chief White lauded Josh's quick action, noting that the incident had the potential to become a structure fire if it hadn't been discovered and reported quickly. White also reminded those present of the importance of working smoke alarms - noting that this was a good example of the difference they can make.



[May 13] Fire season is here. Keeping weeds whacked, mowed and plowed under, brush and trash removed, hedges trimmed, and trees trimmed to at least 6 feet above ground throughout the summer and fall is crucial to maintaining individual properties and the community as a whole fire safe. Remember!
