Entry Deadline: June 15 of the current fair year. No Exceptions!

ENTRY FEE: \$2.00 per animal **MEAT PEN ENRTY FEE:** \$6.00

DOE & LITTER FEE: \$2.00 per rabbit in litter

ALL animals MUST arrive by 12:00 NOON on Sunday

RULES: (In addition to General Rules)

- For sale signs are permitted to be posted on owner's assigned pen. HOWEVER all sales must take place off of the fairgrounds.
 - **ALL RABBITS MUST BE REMOVED FROM FAIRGROUNDS SATURDAY EVENING BY 11:30 PM – NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
1. The current rules of the American Rabbit Breeds Association will govern, in accordance with ARBA.
 2. Rabbit Officials will check all entries for any signs of contagious or infectious diseases before caging. Those animals showing any signs will not be admitted into the show.
 3. For Doe and Litter: Litters must be a minimum of 8 weeks old but not older than 12 weeks old.
 4. Only those animals entered in the show will be permitted into the show. All other animals will not be permitted to enter the show.
 5. In addition to a Senior and Junior class, those six class breeds will also have an Intermediate class.
 6. Cages are available on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE basis, on the condition that they are kept neat and clean. Please indicate the number of pens needed on the entry form.
 7. Dirty cages will result in forfeiture of premiums and other prizes.
 8. All exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their cages at the end of the fair.
 9. Youth may enter open and youth classes, but must pay both entry fees. When a class or age is not indicated or a double fee is not included in the entry fees, all animals will be entered in open class only. If an age is indicated but double entry fees are not included, then the animal will be entered in youth only.
 10. Youth exhibitors must be 18 years of age and under as of January 1 of the current year.
 11. All rabbits must have some form of ID in their ear, either tattoo or permanent marker.
 12. The fair is not responsible for rabbits that escape.
 13. Although not required, showmanship is offered and encouraged. Sign-up Wednesday, Show Day, with the Superintendents.

PREMIUMS: 1st - \$4.00, 2nd - \$3.00, 3rd - \$2.00, 4th - \$1.00
