JIM MARKOWSKI, D/B/A Advanced Tactics & Firearms LLC, respectfully wishes to announce *OPERATIONAL PLANNING* training course that will be offered to members of the federal, state and local law enforcement community. The course will be presented on Thursday October 29, 2015 from 8:30am to 4pm at the Agawam Revolver Club Classroom, 302 Feeding Hills Road, Southwick, MA 01077.

Jim is a retired Special Agent of 33+ years with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives (ATF), where he served as Division Tactical Advisor – Boston Field Division, and member of ATF's Special Response Team (SRT) for 15 years. Jim is an Adjunct Instructor at Anna Maria College in Paxton, MA., where he initially developed an original graduate-level course and presents annually entitled "Operational Planning for Law Enforcement", covering topics such as arrests, search warrants, undercover, surveillance, and multi-agency enforcement operations, as well as the legal and constitutional issues involved.

The course IS DESIGNED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PATROL OFFICERS, PLAINCLOTHES OFFICERS, TACTICAL TEAM MEMBERS AND LEADERS AND POLICE SUPERVISORS, MANAGERS AND ADMINISTRATORS.

The course will include the priorities of life for every enforcement operation, Risk Assessment and Risk Management for planned enforcement operations, mission specific planning, operational plan, briefing, briefback and subsequent debrief. The course will also include target assessments, case background, operational objectives, suspect information, and tactical plan for the specific enforcement operation including initial plan, contingency planning, written plans and why we do the job.

The course will be all classroom interaction between instructor and LEO's in attendance. Suggestions will be offered for consideration regarding UC ops, arrest warrant ops, search warrant

ops. The course will further include group discussion involving enforcement ops with input from each respective group regarding all tactical options available. (TACTICAL TOOLBAG CONCEPT.) This course will further provide suggestions/recommendations what should be included in law enforcement operational plans. The course will provide an “op plan go by” as well as mission specific “checklists” for LEO’s to consider implementing for their respective agencies.

The cost is \$125.00 per LEO and each attendee who successfully completes the course will receive a certification. If two members from the same Department attend the cost will be \$100.00 per person.
