CHANCERY NOTICE

The Bishop also request that all parishes, priest, parishioners take necessary steps to prevent any possible infection and more importantly to curtail any spreading of the infection within our community. The following steps should be encouraged as a public service in instilling good prevention protocols.

1) Any person feeling ill or having symptoms of influenza is requested to voluntarily self-isolate at home until back to health.

2) Wash hands frequently. Proper hand hygiene should be practiced at all times.

3) All persons who have recently returned from China, Korea, Japan, Italy and Iran are advised to self-quarantine for 14 days as per the advisory of the Ministry of Health, Malaysia.

NEW DEVELOPMENT ON MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER(MCO) IMPLEMENTATION IN THE DIOCESE OF PENANG

In strict compliance to the Movement Control Order, the churches, chapels, prayer rooms (where applicable) including the Shrine of St. Anne, Bukit Mertajam will be entirely closed. During the period of restriction MCO has been extended from 18 March, 2020 till 9 June 2020.

Effective from 4 of May, 2020; the main gate of the church will remain closed and only **Individuals** (not in groups) who have a special and urgent reason to see the priest or office staff must first make a proir appointment before the visit. As far as possible, if the matter could be handled by avoiding any physical contact, alternative means of communication should be used – telephone call or email.

Visitors with prior appointments should have their hand sanitized and should be masked. Contact details of visitors will be recorded for the purpose of contact tracing.

These guidelines may be revised from time to time in line with updates and additional SOPs issued by the authorities.

(food for thought) Gospel: Jn. 17: 1-11 *"Models of Love"*

The Gospels speak of Jesus giving his disciples a new commandment: that they love one another as He has loved. To love as Jesus loved is no easy task. We are all influenced by our own likes or dislikes - our own preferences or prejudices. Easy or not, this is how others will know that we are His followers. The God who is Love has commanded us to love in the same manner.

We learn of God's love from the mother of Jesus as well. Mary was a woman totally dedicated to God and family. She was a simple housewife, who struggled with her husband, to keep their little family together in the midst of hard times. Her daily life was not unlike that of any other woman of her time, or of our time. Yet, she totally immersed herself in her God, and in her Son's ministry. Her strength, her faith and her compassion were important components of Jesus' mission. And it was she who taught Jesus the meaning and the potential of human love. If there was ever an example of the active role of a woman in the ministry, Mary is it.

Jesus life was one big embrace. Jesus lived to bring hope, and peace, and compassion. He died for those in prison, for the homeless, for the poor, the prostitutes and sinners, the rejected and the despised. He took time to heal those possessed, the leprous, the dying. He loved them as much as he loved all.

By commanding us to love, Jesus asks us to become instruments of something we didn't fully expect and of something we can never fully understand. We have models to guide us: our own mothers, His mother, Holy Mother Church. But it is up to us to begin the journey.

That's the journey we are taking. That's the work we are to do. That's the kingdom this resurrected and now-ascended Jesus has promised to all of us.
