



Preparation for Ant Control and Treatment

On the above date a technician from EAKO Pest Control (508.588.5897) will be inspecting and treating your units for ants. Prior to the treatment the following preparations are necessary to achieve proper control. Due to the presence of ants in the building, these control procedures will be performed to protect you and the other residents of the building.

How to Prepare for the Service:

Any concerns regarding sensitive health conditions with the use of any listed pesticides, please consult with your physician. Please clear out kitchen and bath sink area cabinets. Clear areas where you have seen ant activity and items should be cleared away from the walls and window sills/sliders. Cover and put away any and all exposed food items. If a perimeter spray is deemed necessary, please be prepared to leave your unit during the service (will need to remove all pets from residence, unplug fish tanks) and be out of the unit for up to 3 hours.

The treatment will consist of applying bait to corners of cabinets, cracks/crevices, baseboards, under kitchen appliances and around trim. The technician may deem it necessary to apply dust into voids/cracks/crevices and inside of walls. Liquid pesticide application (spray) may be deemed necessary to the perimeter of your unit and the technician will inform you if you need to leave the unit.

The Materials Applied: (will include one or more of the following):

- Drax (boric acid, EPA reg. # 9444-131)
- Advion Ant Bait Gel (indoxacarb, EPA reg #100-1498)
- Tempo Dust (cyfluthrin, EPA reg # 432-1373)
- Demand CS (lambda-cyhalothrin, EPA reg # 100-1066)

If you have a health condition that is especially sensitive to certain pest control procedures, please contact your physician and review this notice with your doctor.
