On Friday Dec 22nd, 2017 Hailey was diagnosed with Stage 4
Hodgkin's Lympho-ma, a cancer of the lymphatic system. Tests
concluded that the cancer is in both the top and bottom lymphatic
system, as well as her right hip bone. She also has some lesions on
her ribs, pancreas, and spine. She began receiving chemotherapy
January 4th, 2018. Each treatment costs over \$20,000. All proceeds
from the walk will go to Hailey and to her family to help offset
medical expenses not covered through insurance.

There will be a DJ, a photo booth at the walk. A silent auction/raffle at the Sheridan Fire Department . Sheridan United Methodist church will be hosting a breakfast after the walk.

We are collecting donations for the silent auction. Donations can be dropped off at Village Hall or the Sheridan Fire Department.



Sheridan D.A.R.E. Program Continues

Since 2001 Sheridan Police Chief Chuck Bergeron has taught the D.A.R.E. Program to The Sheridan Grade School 5th grade students.

The fate of the program was questionable in 2017-2018 school year due to School District Unit 2 re-organization of the district where all 5th grade (and above) students were moved to Serena.

This presented a problem for The Sheridan D.A.R.E. Program due to the number of 5th grade students would triple, along with the dollar amount it costs for the program.

"I'm very happy that The Sheridan Village Board along with Serena School District #2 believe in the importance of this program to our young people and together have budgeted \$5,000. to help our kids learn to make good decisions".

Most people think that D.A.R.E. is about preventing drug abuse, it is! However, D.A.R.E. is truly about decision making. Thinking about the choices of everything, considering the consequences good or bad of our choices, and thinking about if the right or wrong choice was made. If there was only one thing I would want our children to take away from D.A.R.E. it would be to think about all their decisions before they make them.
