

## Morning Practice Bass GRADING SCALE

**A (100):** 20+ minutes, 3+ days a week

**C (76):** 20+ minutes, 2 days a week

**E (56):** 20+ minutes, 1 day a week

**NC [no credit] (0):** 0 days a week

**EX [exempt]:** for reasons such as illness, out of town, etc.



### Morning Practice Bass RULES (in addition to the other RULES)

- ♪ Practice is from **8:25 am to 8:45 am**. I arrive at 8:20 am, and encourage you to do the same so you can set-up and be ready to start practicing at 8:25 am.
- ♪ Morning bass practice is a **RED ZONE**.
- ♪ In lieu of getting a parent/guardian signature, you need Mrs. Rosenberg's initials in the minute column for each day of practice. In case Mrs. Rosenberg is not here, ask Mrs. Rossettini (the band teacher) or Ms. Price (the chorus teacher) for their initials.
- ♪ You are also welcome to take a school bass home on the WEEKENDS. The bass must be picked up at the end of the day Friday and returned Monday morning. Make sure to get a parent/guardian signature for the day(s) practiced at home.
- ♪ Since you already have to practice less everyone else to receive an "A," **Mrs. Rosenberg will only modify the grading scale if you do not get in the required practice time for very special circumstances** taken on a case by case basis. PLAN AHEAD; Mrs. Rosenberg recommends coming to practice early in the week in case something happens later in the week.
