

# HAMPSHIRE FIRE DEPARTMENT



Spring is nearly here and

everyone is beginning to get outdoors and get their homes in order starting with their lawn and landscaping. While you work on making your home refreshed and clean up all the yard debris, remember to keep these things in mind. Hampshire has a burn ordinance.



The burn ordinance allows you to burn twigs, branches and logs, no brush material, leaves or lawn clippings. Burning can be done any day of the week from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., but the winds must be less than 10 m.p.h.

Be sure you have a hose handy for quick extinguishment should things get out of hand. Use caution when burning and do not burn too close to any structures. Along with that, remember, this includes cooking on an open-



flame grill. Do not place your grill in the garage or on your deck or balcony, especially if you live in a multi-family dwelling.

Spring is the season when all things renew themselves and with that comes allergy season. The burning of improper materials can make it more difficult for people affected with allergies,

Asthma, COPD or other breathing difficulties, so please keep this in mind.

Smoke Alarms: Everyone needs them! According to NFPA statistics, working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in reported home structure fires in half. The 2007 edition of NFPA 72, the National Fire Alarm Code, requires smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside each sleeping area and on every level. They should also be interconnected so that when one sounds, they all sound.

Approximately 3,000 people per year die in home fires and with proper notification these deaths are preventable. Most smoke detectors have a shelf life of 7-10 years before they need to be replaced. By shelf life we are talking the date when your smoke detector was manufactured. Your smoke detector may have been sitting on the shelf before it was installed in your home, so even though you may have only had it in your home for a few years, the smoke detector may be outdated and need to be replaced.

As a service the Hampshire Fire Department will come out and change the batteries for those that are unable to do so. If you would like fire department personnel to stop by and help you with this lifesaving task, please contact the fire department at (847) 683-2629 and we will be more than happy to change out your batteries for you.
