ORDER

This is a pro se civil action that purports to remove to this Court multiple civil actions involving several Plaintiffs from different courts around the United States. It is before the Court for a frivolity determination. A claim is frivolous “where it lacks an arguable basis either in law or in fact.” Neitzke v. Williams, 490 U.S. 319, 325 (1989). A complaint may be dismissed for failure to state a claim on which relief may be granted when it appears beyond doubt that the plaintiff can prove no set of facts in support of his claim which would entitle him to relief. Scheuer v. Rhodes, 416 U.S. 232, 236 (1974). The document filed by the purported Defendant Kimberly Willis is incomprehensible. To the extent that it seeks to remove the Defendant’s child custody

and contempt actions from the Superior Court of Fulton County, the Court lacks jurisdiction under the domestic relations exception to diversity jurisdiction. This action is *DISMISSED* as frivolous.
