Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. called to order the Village of Bloomingburg regular Board of Trustees Meeting of March 8, 2018 at 7:00pm in the Village of Bloomingburg Hall, Bloomingburg, N.Y.

Regular Meeting

Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. had a meeting with developer regarding the pump station. The pump station needs to have things done to bring it up to date which the developer has agreed to pay for.

Public Comment:

Lesleigh Weinstein: Asked if the Village of Bloomingburg owned the pump station and isn't it our responsibility? Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. stated the previous board took back pump station. The developer has agreed to pay about \$70,000.00 for a chain link fence, black top and new 2nd pump. Lesleigh Weinstein said she has taken pictures at Hickory Court. Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. stated Al Dodd is aware and needs access to do inspections. Lesleigh Weinstein said something needs to be done with the garbage everywhere. Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. said violations have been written.

Holly Roche: Suggested the fine for garbage should be per item. Attorney Alex Smith suggested per day.

Deb Johnson: There are many potholes. Mayor Russell Wood, Jr said they have been filled with cold patch a few times. The blacktop plant is not open in the winter.

Jim Johnson: Asked about LED for the street lighting. Mayor Russell Wood, Jr said they will have to speak to Orange and Rockland about it. Mayor Russell Wood, Jr also said he is going to budget more street lights in this year's budget.

Trustee Aaron Rabiner made a motion to adjourn tonight's meeting seconded by Trustee Rivkah Mosesson. Meeting was adjourned at 7:20pm
