

Join the Bone Marrow Registry

Mitzvah Day 2016!

For Ben William's Mitzvah Project, he is organizing a bone marrow donation drive during Mitzvah Day on April 17th from 9:00 am - 12:30 pm. We are looking for at least 6 adult volunteers to help us collect samples. All you need to do is watch a 5 minute video and help out for 2 hours that day. The samples are collected by taking a long q-tip and swabbing the inside of each cheek for 30 seconds. We would need people to help potential donors fill out the requited paper work and make sure they collect the samples correctly. Kent, Ben and I will be there the whole time. The drive is completely run by us and volunteers.

Bone marrow donation is one of two methods of collecting blood forming cells for bone marrow transplants. Bone marrow donation is a surgical procedure that takes place in a hospital operating room. Doctors use needles to withdraw liquid marrow (where the body's blood-forming cells are made) from both sides of the back of your pelvic bone. You will be given anesthesia and feel no pain during the donation. After donation, your liquid marrow is transported to the patient's location for transplant.

Typically, the hospital stay for marrow donation is from early morning to late afternoon, or occasionally overnight for observation. The donation will take place in a hospital that is experienced and participates in marrow collections for Be The Match[®].






