

## ***MEMBERSHIP RULES***

- 1. All work hours and membership dues must be completed before the Fall Annual Meeting.**
2. Members must attend at least **one** of the two **semi-annual meetings**. If it is impossible to attend one of these meetings, a member may attend three of the 12 board meetings held the first Wednesday of each month.
3. Members must attend or work at least one of the two main fund raiser events.
4. Members must sell or buy the Spring and Fall raffle tickets, or an equivalent to \$60 worth of tickets.
5. Hunting Members must work at least 10 hours for a single membership or 15 hours for a family membership. There will be a charge for un-worked hours. Presently, it is \$20 per hour.
6. Any Member that wishes to pheasant hunt on the F&S property must purchase a pheasant hunting tag from the club. (The fee helps offset the costs of feeding and raising the birds.)

**If you do not meet the above requirements you will not be eligible to hunt on club grounds, including pheasant hunting on club grounds.**

7. Any hunter on the club property must wear an orange hunting hat, and 50% of the upper body must also be orange during the open pheasant season. No bow hunting or turkey hunting during the open pheasant season. (waterfowl hunting is allowed, but the orange clothing requirement will be enforced on club grounds)
8. Hunting Hours: Opening Day - Early 9:00am Late 11:00am \*\* 3:00pm close \*\*  
Rest of season Saturday/Sunday alternating Early 7:30 a.m. Late 9:30 a.m.  
Rest of season Weekdays Normal WI DNR hunting hours.  
No hunting the Saturday morning of opening day of Pheasant season.  
No hunting Fridays and Saturdays after 3:00pm Allowing for pheasant release.
9. All pheasant hunters are to sign in before hunting and must register all birds taken that day. We need this information to keep our program rights within the DNR guidelines.
10. Hunting zones are as follows:
  - No shooting around the club buildings or parking lot.
  - No hunting North of our driveway towards the pines or pheasant pen.
  - No hunting East of the path behind the clubhouse in the woods. These are posted with **No Hunting** signs.
  - Hunt the lower fields South or West. Do not hunt towards the buildings or highway.
- 11. Limit of one bird per day, per hunter, for pheasants until the Wednesday following the last release. After that day the normal DNR regulations will be in effect.**
12. **No guns** in the clubhouse please.

13. Anyone waiting to be a new member must be sponsored by a current member. Once asked they must present themselves to the Board at a Board meeting. The Board will then consider the membership and vote on it. The candidate will be informed of the decision.

### ***18 YEAR OLD MEMBERS GOING TO COLLEGE***

Young people, 18 years of age and out of high school that are coming out of a family membership will automatically be considered as hunting members. They will have to buy a single membership to remain as members in the club even if they are attending college. They will not have to sell the raffle tickets or work the hours if they are not hunting for that year. They will be able to return as hunting members as long as their membership is current. If the member desires to hunt they must put in their work hours, sell the raffle tickets and purchase the pheasant tag like any other member is required to do.

### ***NEW MEMBERSHIPS***

We are not accepting new memberships for hunting at the present time. (new memberships for people wanting to join the club will be placed on a waiting list until there are available spots for hunting) All present members, who remain members, will be permitted to hunt even if they have not hunted prior to this.

Any children of family memberships can hunt when they turn 18 as long as they maintain individual membership in full. (Including the fund raisers, dues, work hours, pheasant tag) Membership dues must be paid before full membership begins.

We will try to keep our hunting member numbers between 65 and 75 if safe to do so. As hunting members drop out or current members choose not to hunt, the Board will decide to take on new members from the waiting list.
