

New Bill Would Up Pay of Army's Enlisted Men

Washington, March 4 (UP)—A senate military affairs subcommittee today approved a bill to increase the pay of army enlisted men from a minimum of \$21 a month to \$42.

The increases in other grades follow:

First class privates, from the present \$36 to \$48 monthly.

Corporals, from \$54 to \$60.

Sergeants, from \$60 to \$78.

Staff sergeants, from \$72 to \$96.

Technical sergeants, from \$84 to \$114.

Master sergeants, from \$126 to \$138.




