

ALPINE FARMS Red Pine Hunter-Jumper Horse Show

June 3rd, 4th, and 5th, 2022

RPHSA is excited to host the second show of the 2022 season at Alpine Farms. Thank you to the Underhill Family for welcoming Red Pine exhibitors to their farm!

Here are a few important items things to know about planning for this new show.

VACCINATIONS & COGGINS: ALL horses are required to have a negative Coggins within the past 12 months and EHV vaccination within the past 6 months. You must bring a copy of both to the show office before unloading your horse. If you showed at a prior 2022 Red Pine show, please confirm with office they have your horse's records on file.

ENTRIES close May 28th, or before, if full. Late entries will be accepted if space allows.

STABLING- *IMPORTANT* If you need a stall, you must email melissamae33@Hotmail.com or text Missy at 763-350-9237 **UNLESS(unless your trainer submitted your barn count—check with your trainer!)**. If you do **NOT** contact Missy for a stall, you will not get a stall even if you selected one during online registration.

Cost of stabling on Friday, Saturday and Sunday is \$65/day (2 bags of shavings are required). Thursday overnight is additional \$20.

Stalls available starting Thursday, June 2nd at 2pm.

SCHOOLING in show rings is available on Thursday, June 2nd from 3pm-6pm. A \$25 schooling fee will be charged (per horse). **RIDERS MUST CHECK IN AT OFFICE TO GET THEIR NUMBERS** before riding.

SHOW RINGS & SCHEDULE

Two arenas: (1) sand outdoor ring and (2) large indoor ring.

FRIDAY/SATURDAY HUNTERS: An identical schedule will run Friday and Saturday for hunters in both arenas. Walk-trot through 2' will be held in indoor arena. Classes 2'3" and up will be held in sand outdoor ring.

SUNDAY JUMPERS: Crossrail, .65m and .75m will be held in indoor arena. The 0.85m and up will be in sand outdoor ring.

SHOW MGMT RESERVES RIGHT TO ADJUST SCHEDULE AS NEEDED AND BASED ON ENTRIES

Schooling should be available each morning before show- rings open at 7:00am; rings close 30 min before classes begin in each ring. Schooling during show will be available in designated grass arena---see Farm map.

Please use designated lunging area---see Farm map.

FEES

Stall fees- see STABLING section above. Shavings \$8/bag. Hay \$10/bale.

Office fee- \$25 per horse

Classes- \$25 per hunter/equitation class; \$35 per jumper class; special classes vary and will be posted at www.horshowsonline.com

Vendor will be available onsite Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
